### INCONSIDERATE PARKING

Please park with thought for others. **Do not park across dropped kerbs,** (Acland Road and Castle Mill) **or on pavements** as it is against the law.

Dropped kerbs are there for push chairs, prams, disabled vehicles and the elderly to have access to and cross the road. Now that we have the **Post Office** in the shop there will be more parking needed so please only park outside the shop for the minimum amount of time necessary.
