#### LANDKEY CAROLS

In the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries there was a tradi-  
tion in Landkey of singing Christmas Carols in the corners of the  
Parish and beyond. Many of these carols were original composi-  
tions and unique to this area, and groups of singers often on farm  
carts would travel around to the surrounding hamlets singing mer-  
rily. An attempt to revive this is being planned, basing it around  
the three primary schools of Landkey, Swimbridge and Newport –  
the schools Along Route 155. It is hoped that funds can be raised  
to employ professional musicians to run carol composing work-  
shops in each school and some Community singing workshops for  
adults. The project will culminate in a gathering in Barnstaple  
Pannier Market on **Friday November 24<sup>th</sup>** where children and  
parents from all three schools will join with others from the three  
Communities to perform some of the old Landkey carols and some  
newly created ones too. A big fund raising effort will be needed  
to fund the project. If you can help or want to be involved your-
