ST PAUL'S CHURCH

We extend a warm welcome to all who would like to join us for Anglican Christian worship at our parish church. New worshippers are especially welcome: if you are considering coming to church for the first time, or after a long break, you do not need to worry that you would be expected to participate in anything that you didn't feel comfortable with! Feel free to come along and find out whether taking part in worship at St Paul's is for you.

Our Sunday services are usually held at 10:30am and Holy Communion is typically offered at least twice per month. A Family Service, which does not include Communion, is held on the first Sunday in the month. These services are enjoyed by the families who come along and they usually include a themed talk aimed at children on a well-known topic from the Bible.

INCONSIDERATE PARKING

Please park with thought for others. **Do not park across dropped kerbs**, (Acland Road and Castle Mill) **or on pavements** as it is against the law.

Dropped kerbs are there for push chairs, prams, disabled vehicles and the elderly to have access to and cross the road. Now that we have the **Post Office** in the shop there will be more parking needed so please only park outside the shop for the minimum amount of time necessary.
