A few years ago we sent around a leaflet to tell all the residents of the village how the Green was run etc. We were very grateful to those who set up annual Bankers Orders to help maintain the Green & to those who made one off donations. We are aware that there are several people who will have moved into the village since then so we thought we would include some information in this newsletter.

- This wonderful facility in the heart of the village is open and accessible to all
- THE GREEN IS OWNED AND MANAGED BY A CHARITABLE TRUST OF LOCAL PEOPLE, NOT A LOCAL AUTHORITY. IT COSTS ABOUT £1,500 EACH YEAR TO MAINTAIN.
- THE TRUST'S DEED PROHIBITS ANY BUILT DEVELOPMENT ON THE GREEN
- WORK DONE ON THE GREEN IS DONE BY LOYAL TEAM OF VOLUNTEERS. EVERY WEEK OF THE YEAR SOMEBODY CHECKS THAT THE GREEN IS IN GOOD ORDER - PERHAPS YOU WOULD LIKE TO JOIN THEM?
