The church's organ, installed in 1877 by Peter Conacher & Co. of Huddersfield, was taken away for restoration in September 2017 and Dame Sarah agreed to rededicate it on its return by Easter 2018. Dame Sarah was Bishop of Crediton when she was invited to rededicate the organ and we are delighted that she will keep this engagement despite her impending move to London to take up the most senior position that a woman has ever held in the Church of England.
