LANDKEY MARKS JUBILEE

'Plant a Tree for the Jubilee' is a slogan approved by HM The Queen as we approach the seventieth anniversary of her accession on February 6th, 1952. So there will be a tree planting in the Orchard on the Millennium Green at **12noon on Sunday, February 6th**. The tree will be a 'Devonshire Quarrenden' apple. It is the variety that received most votes in a poll at the Millennium Green's 21st Birthday Party last September. When the Green approached their Devon supplier they were told in the Autumn 'Sorry, Sold Out', but they found the chosen variety elsewhere. February is not a good time for outdoor Anniversary Celebrations and so the nation's main celebrations will be in June, with Thursday 2nd and Friday 3rd June declared public/bank holidays. A celebration is planned on the Millennium Green on **Saturday 4th June**, with other events at other times being considered as well. Plans are at an early stage of development, so keep your eyes on the Landkey Village website and Landkey Forum. There is the possibility of an open meeting to discuss all the ideas in early April, so look out for the next Newsletter too.
