INCONSIDERATE PARKING

Please park with thought for others. **Do not park across dropped
kerbs,** (Acland Road and Castle Mill) **or on pavements** as it is against
the law.

Dropped kerbs are there for push chairs, prams, disabled vehicles and
the elderly to have access to and cross the road. Now that we have the
Post Office in the shop there will be more parking needed so please
only park outside the shop for the minimum amount of time necessary.
