For those recently diagnosed with dementia and their carers

In October 2017 the Rotary Club of Barnstaple Link initiated the above programme for those living with dementia, including carers. It is designed to stimulate the parts of the brain affected by the dementia (quiet stimulation with an experienced volunteer is offered where required). We started with approximately 20 members and this number has grown over the last 16 months by 50%. Members are invited to participate in memorabilia exercises, seated exercises, craft activities and light quizzes. Live music of various kinds is well received and singalongs and film clips are attractive to our members. We provide light refreshments. We meet at Roundswell Community Centre, on the site of Sainsbury Supermarket every third Thursday in each month from 10am to noon (next dates **February 21st, March 21st April 18th**). 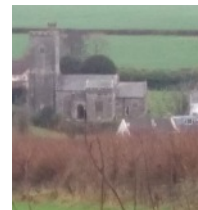
