PROPOSAL – Devon Air Ambulance Community Landing Site at the Landkey Football Pitch

Are you interested in saving lives in Landkey? If so, why don't you join us to find out more about establishing a community landing site for Devon Air Ambulance at the Landkey Parish Council meeting in **February**. Put a note in your diary for **Wednesday, 5th February** at the Old School Rooms.

Devon Air Ambulance has established 135 landing sites across Devon to date, which enable the Charity to land in the heart of communities until 2am every day. If you, or a loved one, should suffer a major trauma during the hours of darkness and need to be rushed from Landkey to Derriford hospital, Plymouth (Devon's major trauma centre), this can take 2 hours by road, but by helicopter its only 20 minutes.

By using surveyed floodlit community landing sites, Devon Air Ambulance can land more quickly and safely in Landkey than using 'dark' sites. At the meeting we will hear all about what's involved with establishing remotely controlled emergency lighting at the Landkey Football Pitch, below the Millenium Green, as well as how we can all get involved in the project.

Devon Air Ambulance can provide a grant towards the costs of establishing a night landing site in Landkey (with funds coming from the **Bank LIBIR Fines**) but like all communities across Devon we know that some project funds would need to be raised locally. Please join us at the Parish Council meeting in February when Toby Russell, from Devon Air Ambulance will give a presentation.
